
Cherry Valley and back roads to Salmon Point

Use this map at your own risk.

16 km one way; mainly flat; very little motor vehicle traffic





From Cherry Valley, travel south approx. 2 km on County Rd 10 then turn right onto County Rd 24 for about 20 meters, then right again onto Brummell Rd. A gentle hill passes farms, then turn left onto Kelly Rd. Follow all of Kelly Rd's jogs (9). Don't turn onto Kings Rd or Rankin Rd: stay on Kelly until you come to Welbanks Rd. There is an osprey nest just east of Welbanks Rd and Kelly Rd. Turn right (north) and stay on this road until you go down a hill and reach County Rd 18. Go left about 50 meters then turn left onto Salmon Pt Rd. Follow this to the end, then retrace your route.

The pavement is good quality throughout. There is very little motor vehicle traffic (excepting county roads 10 and 18), but watch for a couple of loose dogs who, in my experience made a lot of noise but seemed harmless.

There are no washrooms, first aid stations, or food services on this route. There is a small variety store as well as a mom-and-pop restaurant in Cherry Valley.
