

South Bay to Prince Edward Point

20 km one way; 18.5 km paved, 1.5 km hard-packed clay/gravel

Park at the Mariners' Museum, intersection of county roads 10 and 13. The museum folks would appreciate a donation for parking.

Travel south from the museum into a rock cut. The route is nearly flat all the way and very easy to follow: stay on the paved roadway (county road 13). At Babylon Rd. over half way, there's a stop sign: turn left and follow the roadway to Point Traverse., where the pavement ends. The last 1.5 km to Prince Edward Point is mainly hard-packed gravel and clay. Expect a lot of potholes.

There are soft drinks and snacks available in season at the Mariners' Museum; there is also a small winery at Halfmoon Bay.
