

Owl's Head

This is the most popular hike for people with small children. As you can see, it's just off the map.

Follow route 73 from L.P. past the Cascade Lakes; there's a long descent of about a mile or so, then the road levels out for a moment. Watch on your right for a large (1 x 1 meter) brown sign with "Owl's Head Acres" on it. Take this road in the follow it uphill until you come to a "T" junction. This is where the trailhead is (it's not marked, but should be obvious). Park on your left where you see the wider bits of road.

The trail has some steep climbing, but isn't too long -- it takes adults about 15 minutes to go up. There are some very interesting cliffs to see, and a nice view of the peaks to the east (look for the fire tower on Hurricane) and southeast, and into Keene Valley.
