

If summer, and you're at Hough before 2:30 pm, you might be able to include Dix (from Hough) if you're speedy.

5. After Hough, retrace steps to abandoned campsite and descend via Lillian Brook to old logging road or state trail then back to Slide Brook.

4. En route to Hough, look for old campsite at second col.

3. Path from Macomb to the other two Dixes is distinct.

2. Follow Slide Brook upstream; follow slide, when they split, take the one to your left (less steep) & keep going uphill until you hit the distinct path to Macomb along the ridge.

1. Easy hike (1.5 h) from parking lot to Slide Brook; lots of good flat ground for camping at Slide Brook.

**Hiking the Lower Dixes-**  
A nice weekend jaunt in the fall: hike in to base camp at Slide Brook on Friday evening, hike lower Dixes on Saturday, then out Sunday morning.
