
Nun-Da-Ga-O Ridge (formerly known as the Soda Range)

- A 3-5 hour ridge walk with some short scrambles up rocky ledges; many partly-open summit rocks along the ridge affording views to north, west, and south.
- A superb hike at the peak of fall colors.

Parking is at the end of O'Toole Lane. From Rte 73 in Keene, turn at Hurricane Rd (fire station is adjacent to the corner) and head uphill approx 3.5 km to a point where Hurricane road takes a sharp right: O'Toole Lane lies more or less straight ahead at this point. Follow the lane until it ends in a grassy clearing. Note: 2 DEC sign-in/-out boxes.

Travelling notes:

- Recommended route is clockwise; i.e., up Big Crow first, then Weston Mt later, with nice level hike last 1.2 km from Gulf Brook Lean-to out to parking.
- This is a dry trail except for the southern part of the loop on state trails (trail 107 in ADK guide book 13th ed.)
