

Heading to

Street & Nye or Rocky Falls

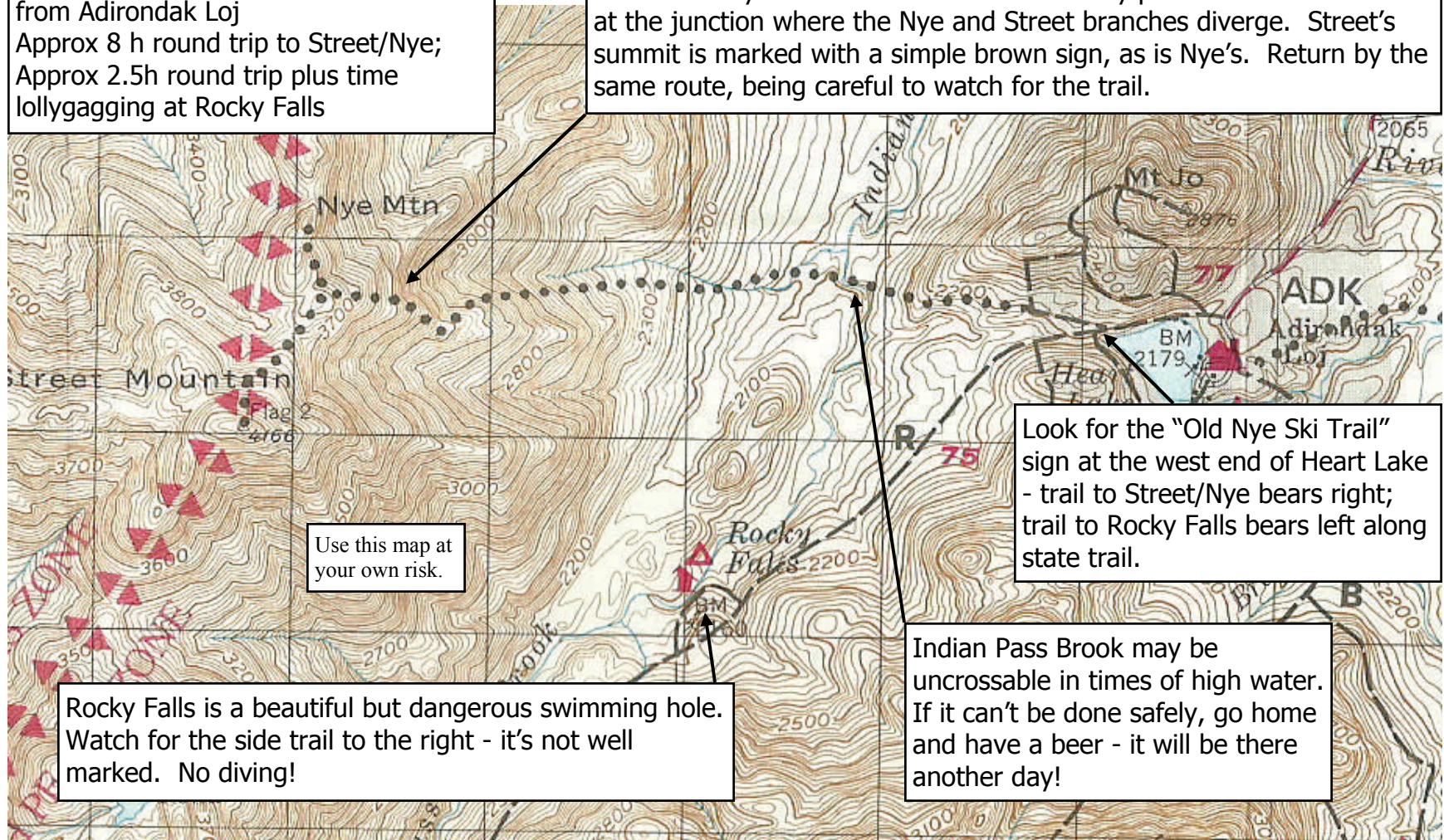
from Adirondak Loj

Approx 8 h round trip to Street/Nye;

Approx 2.5h round trip plus time

lollygagging at Rocky Falls

Street & Nye were infamous for their many dead-end trails in the 1980's, so in the mid 1990's the ADK 46Rs did some trail work to make a single herd path. Watch for occasional flagging tape, and brush work that blocks old trails. Your main clue as to the trail's location will be the muddy rut that is has become in many parts. There is a cairn at the junction where the Nye and Street branches diverge. Street's summit is marked with a simple brown sign, as is Nye's. Return by the same route, being careful to watch for the trail.



Use this map at your own risk.

Rocky Falls is a beautiful but dangerous swimming hole. Watch for the side trail to the right - it's not well marked. No diving!

Look for the "Old Nye Ski Trail" sign at the west end of Heart Lake - trail to Street/Nye bears right; trail to Rocky Falls bears left along state trail.

Indian Pass Brook may be uncrossable in times of high water. If it can't be done safely, go home and have a beer - it will be there another day!
